

To set your dual SIM preferences go All Apps (iii) tap on Settings and select SIM Cards.

You can expand your storage with a microSD memory card (see image on page 5).



Insert the battery from the top and then press it into nlace from the hottom

Because the back cover fits snugly around the phone, you may find it a bit tricky to put on the first time. Start by sliding the top of the phone into the cover and slowly press it into the back cover. ensuring that the rubberized lip completely covers the edges of the screen.



A power adapter and USB cable are not included. To charge your Fairphone, use a standard USB-cable with a micro B connector Connect the USB cable to the USB port located at

the bottom of the phone and then plug it into your computer or a power outlet (using an adapter with a USB port). In addition to charging, you can also use the USB cable to transfer data.

Please make sure that the nominal output of the charger/USB port is 5 Volts and 1 Ampere. Make sure you plug the USB cable in the right way.



## Physical buttons

The Fairphone has only three physical buttons: the volume button, on/off button and camera/shutter

# Navigation buttons

When your Fairphone is turned on, three navigation buttons appear at the bottom of the screen:

- Back: Go one sten back
- Home: Go to the Home panel
- Open Apps: View all open apps






The Settings Shortcuts provides guick access to your Fairphone's basic settings. Swipe your finger down from the top of the screen twice to open the Settings Shortcuts

## Mobile data

A mobile data connection is provided by your operator (via your SIM card) and can be accessed anywhere you have signal coverage. The following icons show you the speed of your data connection: G E 3G H H+ 4G

Mobile data is often included in your service contract, but ensure you understand the related costs - it can be expensive if you're traveling abroad. If you are outside your regular coverage zone your phone will display the roaming icon You can disable your mobile data connection under Settings : in Wireless & Networks.

Wi-Fi is the most common way to access the internet at home, work or a public space like a café. To connect to Wi-Fi

- Go to the Edge Swipe Menu and open All Apps
- Tap Settings
- Tap Wi-Fi in the Wireless & Networks menu Tap on the on/off icon at the top right if Wi-Fi


